What is JADE Health?

JADE Health is a **Joint Action funded by the European Commission** in the framework of the EU4Health Programme. JADE Health aims to reduce the burden of **dementia and other neurological disorders** and to improve the quality of treatment for people living with these diseases.

Background of JADE Health

Neurological disorders pose a significant public health challenge due to their prevalence, impact on quality of life and economic burden, calling for demanding policy action.

Neurological disorders as Alzheimer's disease are the most common cause of dementia, accounting for 60-70% of all dementia cases, currently affecting over 55 million individuals worldwide, among those nearly 8 million in the European Union. Aging of population will increase this public health and society-wide problem.

Objectives

JADE Health adopts a comprehensive and holistic approach to healthcare, focusing on multiple dimensions of **well-being**, from **destigmatisation**, enhancing **preventive measures** and **early detection strategies** to **treatment** options and the development of **effective public policies**.

JADE Health integrates validated best practices and cost-effective interventions across countries and regions through **transnational pilot initiatives**, complementing and reinforcing existing policies and programmes.

- Health literacy and data availability.
- Early detection and risk assessment.
- Stigma reduction and public awareness.
- Predictive modelling and surveillance.
